



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is Winter Warm Up?

Winter Warm Up is an annual Outreach event which Connect hosts along with Turkey Giveaway. At WWU, which is held inside the church building, warm winter clothing and boots are donated by our church members and given away for free in the name of Jesus.

When/Where is WWU?

WWU will be held on **Saturday, November 17** from **9am -1pm** at the Ashland Campus. Items will be organized in the Lower Auditorium and one of the Connect Kids' classrooms.

What items are given away at WWU?

We will be giving away cold weather items, including men's, women's and kid's winter jackets, vests, and heavy sweaters, snow pants, winter and dress boots, hats, mittens, scarves, blankets, and warm comforters. Consider asking co-workers, neighbors, and extended family members to set aside winter clothing to increase what we can give away!

What should I NOT bring?

PLEASE do NOT bring in any clothing other than winter outerwear.
NO pants (unless lined and heavy), no thin sweaters or long-sleeved men's or women's shirts.

How can I help?

- 1.** Bring in new or lightly used winter outerwear to the Ashland Campus during **DROP-OFF WEEK Monday, 11/12 - Thursday, 11/15** anytime between **5-8pm**.
- 2.** Help to accept, sort and organize donations between **Monday - Thursday** from **5-8pm**. Stay for an hour, an evening, or consider sorting what you bring.
- 3.** Serve during the WWU/Turkey Giveaway on **Saturday, November 17** from **9am-1pm**. We will need people to help those who come from the time they enter the building – to lead them through the hallway, talk about Connect, give them directions as to where items are located, answer questions, and be generally life-giving!
- 4.** Help to re-fold, reorganize, and put out additional items of clothing day of the event.

Can my connect group help serve the event?

Yes, your small group can serve during drop-off week as well as the day of to be a blessing to many who don't yet know Jesus!

Can Connect attendees get clothing from WWU?

Yes, our church family may come and get clothing on **Friday, 11/16**, from **5-7 p.m.**
